- **Who:** The kamp will be divided into two age groups.
Kids Kamp I is for children who have completed first through third grade
Kids Kamp II is for children who have completed fourth through sixth grade
- **Where:** Camp Christian (off Hwy 69 south of Hwy 412)
- **When:**
Kids Kamp I: Monday, July 20-Wednesday, July 22, 2009. Registration begins at 2:00 p.m. Camp activities will begin at 2:30. We will dismiss on Wednesday at 11:00 a.m.

Kids Kamp II: Wednesday, July 22-Saturday, July 25, 2009. Registration begins at 2:00 p.m. Camp activities will begin at 2:30. We will dismiss on Saturday at 11:00 a.m.
- **Cost:** Kids Kamp I: \$90 per camper. After July 7, 2009, \$110.
Kids Kamp II: \$120 per camper. After July 7, 2009, \$145.
- **Deadline for Registration:** July 7, 2009 (postmarked on or before July 7, 2009). After July 7, 2009 you must pay late fee. I cannot guarantee a Kamp T-shirt for any late registrations.
- ******ALL MONEY MUST BE RECEIVED BY July 7, 2009 or LATE FEE WILL BE ADDED.**
- **Please send payment in ONE check per church made payable to NEO District Children's Ministries.** *****
- **T-Shirts:** Please email a list of your campers and their T-shirt sizes as soon as you have them available. This assists me in ordering the T-shirts. hollandlinda@cox.net
- **Camper Security:** Your child's security is of utmost importance. Upon arrival at camp drivers will need to come the Camp Office to check in campers. The drivers will be given the cabin assignment at that time.

Anyone coming to visit a child during the camp session must check in at the Camp Office immediately upon arrival. You will be given a visitors badge to wear in exchange for valid picture ID. Before leaving the campground, you must return to the Camp Office and return your badge and I'll return your ID.

If your child needs to leave the campground during camp, or check out early on the closing day, you must submit a signed authorization with your Medical Form that details who will pick up your child, their relationship to the child, reason for departure, and time of return (if applicable). Only this preauthorized person may remove your child from the campground.

In the event of an emergency, a child may only be removed from camp with the approval of the Kamp Director in consultation with the parent/guardian or pastor listed on the camper's application.

- **What we do:** Devotions, chapel, Bible Quizzing, music, swimming, sports, hikes, snacks and much more.
- **Kids Kamp I and II Snack Shack:** The campground Snack Shack will be open two times a day for purchase of snacks. Most snacks are .50 and campers are limited to two items at a time.
- **Dress Code:** All campers and workers are to dress modestly. No short shorts, spaghetti straps, halter tops, bare midriffs or net shirts. Shoes are to be worn at all times. Please bring one pair of shoes you can run in. *All girls' bathing suits must be modest— one piece or tankini suits only---NO two-piece suits will be allowed.* A shirt must be worn over all swimsuits going and coming from the pool area.
- **What to bring:** Bible, towel/washcloths, comb/brush, sturdy and comfortable shoes, sports clothes (that you can get wet in), bathroom toiletries, sleeping bags or sheets and blanket, pillow. Please mark all items with campers name. Please bring an offering for our "adopted missionary child".
- **What NOT to bring:** Radio/walkman, electronic/video games, fireworks, water guns, weapons (including pocket knives), tobacco, drugs or alcohol.
- **Camp Rules:** All campers and workers are to follow the assigned schedule and guidelines. Disobedience of camp rules may, at the director's discretion, result in parents having to come to camp and take their child home. If a child is sent home, the camp fee will not be refunded.
- **Medication Packaging Requirements:**
 - ALL Medications must be in their original container with dosages clearly printed on the bottle.
 - All medications must be placed in a Ziploc bag and labeled with your child's name.
 - A list of medication names should be included on the label of the Ziploc bag.
 - Medications are to be given to the adult who is bringing your child to camp.
 - ALL MEDICATIONS MUST BE GIVEN TO THE CAMP NURSE UPON ARRIVAL.
